A leading scholar in environmental management and disaster risk studies, Dr. HMMB Seneviratne played a key role in establishing the Department of Environmental Management at Rajarata University of Sri Lanka and has worked extensively as a researcher and adviser on natural hazards and disaster management. He has held senior academic and research appointments in Sri Lanka, Nigeria, and Norway, including with the University of Maiduguri and the Trondheim-Peradeniya Collaboration at NTNU. He graduated from the University of Ceylon, Peradeniya (1966), and earned an MPhil in Geomorphology from the University of Nottingham and a PhD in Resettlement and Health from NTNU, Norway. He began his academic career at the University of Ceylon, Colombo, carried out a UNDP/FAO-funded soil erosion survey in 1975, and later continued his international academic and research work before returning to Sri Lanka, where he remains active as a freelance researcher and advisor.
